

Audiology Evaluation Instructions

Outpatients should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their first visit in order to complete the registration process.

- Bring photo identification.
- Bring *all* health insurance cards. Patients without healthcare insurance will be offered services upon agreement to a self-pay plan.

Hearing Screens (30 minutes)

Babies coming due to a failed hearing screen at birth. Includes OAEs and ALGOs. Testing requires baby to be asleep or quiet and still for 30 to 45 minutes.

- Bring baby tired.
- Can feed baby when you arrive to the appointment.
- Try not to let baby sleep in the car on the way to the appointment.

Hearing Tests (1 hour)

Children over six or seven months corrected age (corrected age means the age they would be if they were born on time).

CAPD Evaluations (2.5 hours)

Scheduled when the child is alert and awake.

- Child must be at least 7 years of age.
- Keep child on medication if prescribed.

Unsedated ABR (1.5 hours)

Babies between the ages of one week and six months need to be scheduled for an auditory brainstem response test. Times are scheduled whenever the baby sleeps naturally. Pre-test instructions include the following.

- Sleep deprivation (keep up late, wake up early and don't let them sleep in the car).
- Hold feeding prior to test.
